FACTS OF RECORD

Maya, this is everything this report is built on.

Seven answers. Nothing else. If a line below is wrong, the reading built on it is wrong, and you can see that for yourself before you read another page.

WHERE IT STANDS RIGHT NOW	No contact. He ended it or disappeared.
HOW LONG IT HAS BEEN PULLING AT YOU	6 months to 2 years
READINGS ABOUT HIM BEFORE THIS ONE	Yes. They kept saying he would come back.
WHAT YOU NEED TO WALK AWAY WITH	The honest read of where you stand.
WHAT HE HAS DONE IN THE LAST TWO WEEKS	None of these. He has done none of it. These are the six lines of the rule, and you ticked them yourself. Page 5 holds the rule against this answer and against nothing else.
FIRST NAME	Maya
BIRTH DATE AND TIME	October 2, 1993 · 9:40 pm Birth place: not collected. Page 4 explains exactly what that costs you.

Read this before you read anything else. This case is a composite of public posts. She is not a customer. We do not have any yet, and this page will tell you why.

The seven answers above are not one real woman's record. They were composed from public posts in which women describe this exact situation, and the name and the birth data are invented, so that you can see a finished reading before you pay for one.

We are not going to invent a customer, we are not going to write our own testimonial, and we are not going to put five stars on a page for a product nobody has bought yet. What we can show you is the work. That is this document, in full, with nothing removed.

- WHAT THIS READING CANNOT DO
- **It cannot tell you what he will do.** No reading can. We never collected a single piece of information about him, so anything we said about his chart, his feelings or his intentions would be invention.
 - **It cannot place your planets in houses.** Houses need a birth place, and we do not ask for one. Where a placement is not fixed by the data you gave us, we say so instead of guessing. Page 4.
 - **It cannot give you a probability.** There is no number in this report telling you how likely he is to come back. We do not have one, and anyone who gives you one made it up.
 - **It cannot end the feeling.** It can end the guessing about where you stand, and hand you a plan you can start tomorrow.

PART 1 · THE BOND, CHARTED

What your chart **actually** shows

Three placements in your chart are fixed by the birth date and time you gave us, and they hold no matter which part of the world you were born in. We checked. Those three are below, and they are the only ones this report will build on. Everything a reading can honestly say about you sits in a smaller box than the internet wants you to believe, and this is that box.

SUN IN LIBRA	The instinct to weigh both sides, including his. It is the placement that makes you fair, and it is the same placement that has you building his case for him at 2am when he is not there to make it himself.
VENUS IN VIRGO	Venus is how you love. In Virgo, love arrives as attention to detail: you notice what he needed before he said it. The shadow of that gift is the one you are living in now, because the same attention, pointed at a silence, will find meaning in a story-view.
MERCURY CONJUNCT MARS IN SCORPIO	Your thinking and your drive sit on the same degree, in the sign that does not do shallow. It is why you cannot think about this casually, why you research instead of resting, and why three readings were never going to be enough. This is not weakness. It is horsepower pointed at a locked door.

You did not fall harder than other people because you are weaker than other people. You fell harder because you notice more, and you have been pointing all of it at nine weeks of nothing.

Put those three together and you get a woman built to investigate. That is what your chart shows, and it is worth saying plainly what it does not show: not that this connection was fated, not that it was karmic, not that it was rare. Millions of people share these placements and most of them will never meet him. What your chart explains is why the ending landed the way it did on you, and why the waiting has been this expensive. It does not explain him, and this report will not pretend otherwise.

PART 1 · CONTINUED

What your chart **does not show**, and why we are telling you

This is the page every other reading you paid for left out, and it is the reason this one costs you a single payment instead of a subscription. Here is what we did not have, and therefore did not use.

YOUR MOON	We cannot tell you your Moon sign, and we are not going to guess it. You gave us a birth time, but the timezone of that time depends on your birth place, and we never asked for it. On your date, the Moon crosses from Aries into Taurus inside that window. Any reading that hands you a confident Moon sign from the data you gave us is guessing and calling it a chart.
YOUR HOUSES	No houses. None. We cannot place a single planet in a house without a birth place, and we never asked you for one. If a reading told you your Moon sits in your 7th house of partnership, ask yourself when you gave them the city you were born in. You did not.
THE SLOW PLANETS	Your Saturn squares your Pluto, and your Uranus sits on your Neptune. Both are real, both are in your chart, and both are shared by everyone born in your years. They are a description of your generation, not of you, and we will not sell them back to you as destiny.
HIS CHART	Nothing. We have no birth data for him, because we never asked for any. That means no synastry, no composite chart, no aspects between your chart and his, and no statement about what he feels or what he will do. Any reading that gave you that from your data alone invented it.

You have been told, by three readings, that the stars said he was coming back. The stars did not say that. The stars cannot say that, and this page is the receipt for why. What is left after you take the guessing out is smaller, and it is yours, and it is on the next page.

A reading that never tells you what it does not know has no way of being wrong, and something that cannot be wrong is not information. It is comfort with a price tag.

PART 2 · THE RULE, APPLIED TO YOUR FACTS

Your verdict, and the rule it was reached under

The rule, printed on the page where you bought this, before you paid: What counts is his action, addressed to you, in words, with follow-through. Each criterion below is held against one thing: the boxes you ticked when we asked what he has done in the last two weeks. That answer is on page 2, because we asked you for it instead of inferring it from your chart.

Direct contact, addressed to you, not a story-view, not a like. Words, sent on purpose.	Box empty. No words from him, sent on purpose, to weigh.	NO

He proposes something concrete with a time and a place, and shows up to it.	Box empty. Nothing proposed. No time, no place.	NO
Consistency across two weeks or more. One good Tuesday is a mood. Fourteen days is a direction.	Box empty. Nothing to be consistent with. Zero days, not fourteen.	NO
He accepts a no without punishing you with silence or guilt.	Box empty. Untestable: no approach, so no no to accept.	N/A

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The threshold, unchanged from the page you read before you paid: Before you change any decision you have made, at least three of those boxes have to be checked, and they have to hold for fourteen days. Moods do not get to steer months.

YOUR VERDICT, UNDER THAT RULE

Under the rule printed above, the facts you reported check none of the six boxes, against a threshold of three sustained for fourteen days. On your reported facts, this classifies as a chapter: a connection that is complete on the evidence available. That is a classification of your answers under a published rule. It is not a statement about him, and it is not a prediction.

Here is the whole reasoning, so you can attack it. Every one of the six criteria requires an action from him, addressed to you, in words. We did not read those actions out of your chart. We asked you, one box per criterion, and you ticked None of these. No box is checked, the threshold of three is not met, and it is not close. PART 3 · YOUR THREE SCENARIOS

The three ways this can go, and how you will recognize each one

We are not ranking these, and we are not putting a percentage on any of them. We do not know which one you are in, and nobody who has never met him does. What we can give you is the early signs of each, so that when something happens you can place it against the rule on page 5 instead of googling at midnight.

SCENARIO ONE**The quiet completion.**

The silence continues. No dramatic closure arrives, no final conversation. Over the coming weeks the charge on his name drops, not because you forced it but because you stopped feeding it. It is quieter and more survivable than it looks from where you are sitting tonight.

Early signs: A day passes without you checking anything of his. Music he liked stops ambushing you. The urge to reread old messages arrives, and passes, without being obeyed.

SCENARIO TWO**The door reopens.**

He reaches out. If that happens, what matters is HOW, and you now have a rule for it instead of a feeling. A clear message that names what he did clears three of the six criteria in one move. A vague late-night check-in clears none of them. The plan on page 7 covers this, so you answer from footing rather than from famine.

Early signs: Criteria one, two and three checked in the same message: direct words, sent on purpose, naming what happened, asking about your life. Anything less than that is scenario one wearing a costume, and the rule on page 5 will tell you which you are looking at.

SCENARIO THREE**The long shadow.**

Neither completion nor return. Months of intermittent, low-effort contact that keeps the wound open without ever committing to heal it. This is the one to watch for, because it feels like hope while functioning like a leash. Under the rule, it is easy to spot: it checks criterion one occasionally and never checks criterion five.

Early signs: Sporadic reactions to your posts, holiday texts with no follow-up, warmth that spikes exactly when you start moving on. Contact that never survives fourteen days. If you see the pattern twice, name it and use page 8.

PART 4 · YOUR 30-DAY PATH

If the door **genuinely** opens

Use this path only if scenario two arrives in the form the rule recognises: direct words, addressed to you, naming what happened. Until then, live from the closed-door path on page 8, because footing serves you in every scenario and waiting serves you in none.

DAYS 1-3 Do not answer within the first day. Not as a game, but because your first draft will be written by nine weeks of hunger. Write the reply, sit on it overnight, send the version morning-you still stands behind.

DAYS 4-10 One honest conversation, one topic: what happened, in his words. You are gathering information, not auditioning. If his account blames the timing, the stress, or you, then criterion two is not met, whatever it felt like to hear from him.

DAYS 11-20 If his account holds up: slow rebuild, in public, in daylight. Coffee, not couches. Your Venus in Virgo will want to fix the logistics of the reunion before the reunion has earned any. Let him earn chapters instead of handing him the book back.

DAYS 21-30 Review on day 30, alone, on paper, with the six criteria in front of you. How many boxes did he actually check, and did they hold for fourteen days? A door reopened is a probation, not a restoration. You decide at the end of it, from strength.

The rule that protects you on this path: every step above is something you do for your own footing. None of it is a performance for him, and none of it depends on his response to work.

PART 4 · CONTINUED

If it is time to close the door yourself

This is your default path starting tomorrow, and it stays your path unless the threshold on page 5 is met. It is not about him. Every step is a stitch in your own fabric.

DAYS 1-3 The digital fast: mute, do not block, unless muting proves too porous. Muting is a boundary you own. Blocking is a message you send, and you are done sending messages.

DAYS 4-10 Reclaim one thing the relationship colonized: the playlist, the cafe, the Sunday ritual. Go there, deliberately, once, and let it be strange. It gets less strange exactly once you have done it.

DAYS 11-20 The letter you never send: everything he did not stay to hear, written by hand, then put away. Your nervous system needs the exhale far more than he needs the information.

DAYS 21-30 One future-facing act with a date on it: the class, the trip, the application. Waiting shrank your calendar to the size of his silence. Days 21 to 30 are where your calendar gets its horizon back.

Closing a door is not the same as saying it meant nothing. It is saying it mattered, and it is over, and both of those can be true at once.

THE CHAPTER NOBODY ELSE WRITES

When nothing happens

Thirty days from now, there is a real possibility that none of the early signs from your scenarios have appeared. No message. No sign. No closure delivered to your doorstep. We have not found this chapter in any reading we reviewed, and here is the honest reason it is missing: a reading that ends your question ends the sale.

For your facts, under the rule on page 5, quiet is not a cliffhanger. It is the same answer you already have, holding. The verdict said zero of six, and thirty days of silence is thirty more days of zero of six. Nothing new has arrived to interpret, and that is not fate withholding a message from you. It is the rule doing exactly what it said it would do, which is the whole reason it was printed before you paid.

So there is nothing here to decode, and no reason to buy a fourth reading to decode it. If day 30 is silent, you are not stuck. You are in scenario one, you are ten steps into the plan that answers it, and the next move was always going to be yours.

Silence, held long enough, is an answer you are allowed to accept. Not the loud, satisfying answer you were owed, but an answer.

If day 30 arrives quietly, you do not need another reading to interpret the quiet. You need the second path in Part 4, and you have already read it.

CLOSING

What we owe you, Maya

Maya, three readings took your money and told you to wait. We would rather be the last reading you ever buy about this man. You now have your own words on page 2, the rule on page 5, the fact that would overturn it, and thirty days that belong to you in either direction. What you do not have is a promise about him, because we never had one to sell.

Whatever the next months bring, the waiting is optional now. You have your own facts in writing, the rule they were held against, the line that would overturn the result, and a path for either outcome. That was always the point. Not him. You, moving.
